

**INVITATION TO BIDDERS**

Sealed Bids addressed to Sienna Management District, Attention: Ms. Linda C. Bell, President, Board of Directors, will be received electronically **or** at the office of LJA Engineering, Inc., the office of the Engineer, LJA Engineering, Inc., 1904 West Grand Parkway North, Suite 120, Katy, Texas 77449, until 10:00 a.m. Local Time, Tuesday, February 14, 2023, and then publicly opened and read at the office of the Engineer, LJA Engineering, Inc., 1904 West Grand Parkway North, Suite 120, Katy, Texas 77449 for "Sienna Mobility Improvements - Sienna Parkway at Sienna Springs for Sienna Management District, Fort Bend County, Texas." Scope of Work of the Contract Documents includes the following: Construction of this project will begin 355' South of Sienna Springs Boulevard and end 415' South of Trammel Fresno Road. This section of the project includes widening the northbound and southbound approaches. Roadway improvements will consist of 8" concrete pavement and 8" lime stabilized subgrade, also replacing the existing sidewalk on the west side of the project limits. Drainage improvements include the addition of slope paving and fumes behind the curb where there is no existing sidewalk. A complete redesign of the traffic signal will also occur at the intersection.

Bids received after the closing time will be returned unopened. A **MANDATORY** pre-bid conference will be held in-person on Tuesday, February 7, 2023, at 10:30 a.m. Local Time at the office of the Engineer, LJA Engineering, Inc., 1904 West Grand Parkway North, Suite 120, Katy, Texas 77449. The pre-bid conference will also be held via teleconference. To attend the audio format **MANDATORY** pre-bid conference, dial +1 346-202-6170, Phone Conference ID: 915 200 28#. Attendance by each prospective bidder or its representative at the pre-bid conference is **MANDATORY**, and no Bid will be opened unless the bidder or representative was present at the pre-bid conference either in person or via teleconference.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond or a certified or cashier's check, acceptable to the Owner, in an amount not less than two percent (2%) of the total amount Bid, as a guarantee that the successful bidder will enter into the Contract Documents and execute the Bonds on the forms provided and provide the required insurance certificates within seven (7) days after the date Contract Documents are received by the Contractor. If a certified or cashier's check is provided, the successful bidder shall deliver, at the bid opening address, the original certified or cashier's check within twenty-four (24) hours of receipt of the bid opening.

Bidding documents may be examined at LJA Engineering, Inc., AGC of Texas, Construct Connect, and Amtek or may be obtained by prospective bidders or suppliers upon payment of \$100.00 non-refundable plus cost of delivery (\$50.00 for electronic copy) for each set of documents at LJA Engineering, Inc., 1904 West Grand Parkway North, Suite 120, Katy, Texas 77449, or at <https://bids.lja.com>. Checks should be made payable to LJA Engineering, Inc. No cash will be accepted.

A bidder submitting electronic Bids must submit its Bid and Bid Securities in compliance with Owner's Order Adopting Section 49.2731 Electronic Bidding Rules and all electronic Bids and Bid Securities must be submitted through <https://bids.lja.com>. Bidders must register and obtain bidding documents on this website for the requirement payment amount (if any) to submit an electronic bid.

By submitting a Bid, bidder acknowledges and agrees that the Contract Documents may be accepted, executed or agreed to through the use of an Electronic Signature, as defined by and in accordance with Owner's Electronic Signature Rules for Construction Contracts.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive all defects and irregularities in bidding or bidding process except time of submitting a Bid. The successful bidder, if any, will be the responsible bidder which in the Board's judgment will be most advantageous to the District and result in the best and most economical completion of the Project.

**The requirements of Subchapter J, Chapter 552, Government Code, may apply to this Bid and the Contractor agrees that the Contract Documents can be terminated if the Contractor knowingly or intentionally fails to comply with a requirement of that subchapter.**
