NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Online bids will be received by the City of Burlington, Colorado for Airfield Pavement Maintenance at Kit Carson County Airport (ITR) through www.questcdn.com. Electronic bidding will open on **April 23, 2026, at 8:00 a.m./p.m. (MDT)** and will close on **April 29, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. (MDT)**. All bidders submitting bids electronically must be registered with QUESTCDN. A virtual reading of the bids will be held for all prospective bidders thirty (30) minutes after the bid deadline. The bid opening will take place via Microsoft Teams. The Microsoft Teams application is not required, and the meeting can be accessed through the web-based version of Microsoft Teams. BID SCHEDULES: The Project includes multiple bid schedules, each representing a distinct Scope of Work. The bid schedules are identified as follows:

- ➔ Schedule 1: Runway 15-33 Pavement Maintenance
- ➔ Schedule 2: Taxilane Pavement Maintenance (Locally Funded)
- ➔ Schedule 3: Apron Marking

Each Bid Schedule is described in greater detail in the Bidding Documents and Bid Proposal Form.

DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK. The project is anticipated to be funded, in whole or in part, by grants from the Federal Aviation Administration. The Work consists of construction, rehabilitation, and/or improvements of Runway 15-33, taxilane, and apron, as shown on the Plans and described in the Contract Documents. The Work will interface with existing airport facilities and infrastructure, as applicable. The limits of construction and general site conditions are illustrated on the plans.

AVAILABILITY OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS. A digital download of the Contract Documents and other related contract information is available for purchase online at www.questcdn.com for \$42.00, payable directly to QuestCDN. This cost includes access to online bidding. **No refunds will be issued.** The QuestCDN project number is **10065073**. Bid quantities and schedules can be viewed prior to purchase by selecting the "View Bid Documents" option on QuestCDN.

BID SECURITY. Each online bid submission must include a PDF copy of a Bid Bond, executed by a Surety Company, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid, made payable to the City of Burlington, Colorado, and uploaded to QuestCDN as part of the bid submission process.

BID SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS. Bidders are required to provide all information requested in the proposal forms and specifications and must submit bids on all items within every schedule. The City of Burlington, Colorado, reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all portions of bid items. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days following the bid opening.

VIRTUAL PRE-BID MEETING. A non-mandatory virtual pre-bid meeting for all prospective bidders will be held via Microsoft Teams on **April 14, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. (MDT)**.
