INVITATION TO BIDDERS

Sealed Bids, in duplicate, addressed to Brazoria County Municipal Utility District No. 43, Attention: Raymond Ruiz, President, Board of Directors, will be received at the office of LJA Engineering, Inc., 1904 West Grand Parkway North, Suite 120, Katy, Texas 77449, until 3:30 p.m., Local Time, Wednesday, March 13, 2019, and then publicly opened and read for “Construction of the Phase 1 Detention and Drainage Facilities to Serve Del Bello Lakes for Brazoria County Municipal Utility District No. 43, Brazoria County, Texas”.

Scope of Work of the Contract includes the detention and drainage.

Bids received after the closing time will be returned unopened. A **MANDATORY** pre-bid conference will be held on Wednesday, March 6, 2019, at 3:30 p.m. Local Time, at LJA Engineering, Inc., 1904 West Grand Parkway North, Suite 120, Katy, Texas 77449. Attendance by each prospective bidder or its representative at the pre-bid conference is **MANDATORY**, and no Bid will be opened unless the bidder or representative was present at the pre-bid conference.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a bid bond or a certified or cashier’s check, acceptable to the Owner, in an amount not less than 5 percent of the total amount bid, as a guarantee that the successful bidder will enter into the Contract and execute the Bonds on the forms provided and provide the required insurance certificates within 7 days after the date Contract Documents are received by the Contractor.
